## Alarm Systems - Registration and Renewal - Penalties

- 3 FOR the purpose of authorizing a county and a municipality to impose a penalty against 4 an alarm system contractor for the alarm system contractor's or the alarm user's 5 failure to register an alarm system under certain circumstances; authorizing a 6 county and a municipality to impose a penalty against an alarm system contractor 7 for the alarm system contractor's or the alarm user's failure to renew an alarm system's registration within a certain number of days after a certain request for 8 service under certain circumstances; defining certain terms; and generally relating 9 10 to alarm system registration and renewal.
