Natural Resources – Hunting – Black Bears

- FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from hunting or participating in a hunt for black
 bears without first obtaining a permit from the Department of Natural Resources;
 establishing an exception, applicable in Allegany County and Garrett County and if
 the Department uses a lottery process to issue a limited number of permits, that
 authorizes a person to hunt black bears on property the person owns during the open
 season without a permit under certain circumstances; and generally relating to
 hunting black bears.

(A) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, A PERSON MAY NOT HUNT OR PARTICIPATE IN A HUNT FOR BLACK BEARS UNLESS THE PERSON FIRST OBTAINS A PERMIT FROM THE DEPARTMENT.
