2 (B) EACH FIRST RESPONDER SHALL COMPLETE AN AUTISM AWARENESS 3 TRAINING PROGRAM APPROVED BY THE MARYLAND POLICE TRAINING AND 4 STANDARDS COMMISSION UNDER § 3–219 OF THIS ARTICLE.

5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 6 October 1, 2018.
