

3 4 5 6	FOR the purpose of altering the composition of a scenic river advisory board in Frederick County if the scenic or wild river for which the board was created flows through Frederick County and one or more other counties; making stylistic changes; and generally relating to scenic river advisory boards.
7 8 9 10 11	BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Article – Natural Resources Section 8–403 Annotated Code of Maryland (2012 Replacement Volume and 2017 Supplement)
12 13	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
14	Article - Natural Resources
15	8–403.
16	(a) (1) (I) There is a Scenic and Wild Rivers Review Board.
17 18 19 20	(II) The Board consists of the Secretaries of Natural Resources, Agriculture, and the Environment and the Director of Planning and a member of the Garrett County Commissioners, who shall be a voting member of the Board only on matters pertaining to the wild portion of the Youghiogheny River.
21	(2) The members of the Board shall select the chairperson.
22	(3) A member of the Board:





- 1 advisory board shall consist of no more than the following members: 2 [2] TWO residents of each county through which the scenic or wild river 3 flows who own land contiguous to the scenic or wild river; [2] TWO residents of each county through which the scenic or wild river 4 (2)5 flows who do not own land contiguous to the scenic or wild river; 6 (3)[2] TWO representatives of the local governing body of each county 7 through which the scenic or wild river flows; and 8 [1] ONE representative of each soil conservation district through which the scenic or wild river flows. 9 10 Each local scenic and wild river advisory board shall: (e) 11 Review any inventory, study, plan, and regulation that is proposed 12 under this subtitle and is applicable to any river in its jurisdiction; 13 Make recommendations on the inventory, study, plan, and regulation 14 to its local governing body and to the Scenic and Wild Rivers Review Board; (3)Select its own chairperson; and 15 16 Adopt its own administrative regulations for the operation of the local **(4)** 17 advisory board. (f) Each member of a local advisory board may not: 18 (1)19 (i) Receive compensation for service; or 20 Be reimbursed for expenses incurred in travel or for attending 21meetings or performing any official duty. 22(2)The Secretary shall schedule meetings for each local advisory board. 23However, in the event of emergencies, the chairperson of a local advisory board may 24schedule meetings for the local advisory board. 25[Upon] ON completion of an approved management plan, the local 26 governing body may establish a scenic river advisory board for each designated scenic or wild river within its jurisdiction. 27
- 28 **(2)** Each board, as constituted by the local authority, may recommend policies, laws, and regulations in furtherance of the aims of this subtitle to the appropriate local governing body.

- 4 (II) IF A SCENIC OR WILD RIVER FLOWS THROUGH FREDERICK COUNTY AND ONE OR MORE OTHER COUNTIES, THE SCENIC RIVER ADVISORY BOARD SHALL CONSIST OF THE FOLLOWING MEMBERS:
- Two residents of each county through which the scenic or wild river flows who own land contiguous to the scenic or wild river;
- 10 2. TWO RESIDENTS OF EACH COUNTY THROUGH WHICH 11 THE SCENIC OR WILD RIVER FLOWS WHO DO NOT OWN LAND CONTIGUOUS TO THE 12 SCENIC OR WILD RIVER;

- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2018.
