State Government - Grants and Contracts - Reimbursement of Indirect Costs

- FOR the purpose of requiring that the terms of a certain grant or contract allow for reimbursement of indirect costs at the same rate the nonprofit organization has negotiated to receive for certain reimbursement or, under certain circumstances, at a rate of at least a certain percent; providing for the application of this Act; defining certain terms; and generally relating to State-funded grants and contracts.

- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

- 19 (2) "Indirect costs" means any costs that would be

- 21 (3) "NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION" MEANS AN ORGANIZATION THAT IS
- 22 TAX EXEMPT UNDER § 501(C)(3), (4), OR (6) OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE.

- 1 (B) IF A NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION IS A DIRECT RECIPIENT OR 2 SUBRECIPIENT OF A GRANT OR CONTRACT THAT IS FUNDED EITHER PARTIALLY OR
- 3 WHOLLY WITH STATE FUNDS, THE TERMS OF THE GRANT OR CONTRACT SHALL
- 4 ALLOW FOR REIMBURSEMENT OF INDIRECT COSTS:
- 5 (1) AT THE SAME RATE THE NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION HAS
- 6 NEGOTIATED TO RECEIVE FOR REIMBURSEMENT OF INDIRECT COSTS UNDER A
- 7 FEDERAL AWARD; OR
- 8 (2) IF THE NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION HAS NOT NEGOTIATED A 9 FEDERAL REIMBURSEMENT RATE, AT A RATE OF AT LEAST 10%.
- 10 (C) THIS SECTION APPLIES WHETHER OR NOT THE FUNDS AWARDED
- 11 THROUGH THE GRANT OR CONTRACT ARE TRANSFERRED DIRECTLY BY THE STATE
- 12 OR THROUGH A THIRD PARTY TO THE NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION.
