13 14	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
15	Article – Education

17 18	(b) (1) The salary of a county superintendent may not be decreased during the superintendent's term of office.
19 20	(2) Each county superintendent shall devote full time to public school business.
21 22	(3) IN BALTIMORE COUNTY, THE COUNTY SUPERINTENDENT MAY NOT ENGAGE IN OTHER EMPLOYMENT.



SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, § 35 of the Maryland Constitution, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to the salary or compensation of the Baltimore County Superintendent of Schools while serving in a term of office beginning before the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary or compensation of the Baltimore County Superintendent of Schools shall take effect at the beginning of the next following term of office. This limitation does not apply to an individual appointed or elected after the effective date of this Act to fill out an unexpired term.

9 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 10 1, 2018.
