A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Baltimore City – Education – Junior Reserve Officer Training Corps Instructors**

3 FOR the purpose of applying to Baltimore City a certain definition of “public school
4 employee” that includes Junior Reserve Officer Training Corps (JROTC) instructors
5 for the purpose of certain provisions of law related to organizations of certificated
6 employees; and generally relating to representation for JROTC instructors in
7 Baltimore City.

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

19 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 **Article – Education**

21 6–401.

22 (a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.

23 (e) (1) “Public school employee” means a certificated professional individual
24 who is employed by a public school employer or an individual of equivalent status in

1 Baltimore City, except for a county superintendent or an individual designated by the
2 public school employer to act in a negotiating capacity as provided in § 6–408(c) of this
3 subtitle.

4 (6) In **BALTIMORE CITY**, Baltimore County, Calvert County, Charles
5 County, and Garrett County, “public school employee” includes Junior Reserve Officer
6 Training Corps (JROTC) instructors.

7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
8 1, 2018.
