Natural Resources – Public Shellfish Fishery Area – Standards

- FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of Natural Resources to establish areas in the Chesapeake Bay as part of the public shellfish fishery area if the areas have a certain density of oysters; requiring the Department to establish certain natural oyster bars as part of the public shellfish fishery area; and generally relating to standards for the establishment of the public shellfish fishery area.

- 18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND.
- 19 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 Article - Natural Resources

- 22 (a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.
- 23 (j) "Natural oyster bar" means any submerged oyster bar, reef, rock, or area 24 represented as an oyster bar on the charts of the Oyster Survey of 1906 to 1912 and its



1 amendments.

- 2 (l) "Public shellfish fishery area" means an area in which shellfish is harvested 3 for commercial purposes.
- 4 (q) "Yates Bar" means any submerged oyster bar, reef, rock, or area represented as an oyster bar on the charts of the Oyster Survey of 1906 to 1912, not including any 6 amendments.

- 8 (a) (1) In consultation with the Oyster Advisory Commission AND SUBJECT
 9 TO PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, the Department shall identify by regulation
 10 the public shellfish fishery area in the Chesapeake Bay based on commercial harvesting
 11 activity during the 3 years preceding June 1, 2009, any surveys conducted by the
 12 Department, and other quantitative data known or made available to the Department.
- 13 (2) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ESTABLISH AS PART OF THE PUBLIC
 14 SHELLFISH FISHERY AREA ANY AREA IN THE CHESAPEAKE BAY, INCLUDING ANY
 15 APPROPRIATE YATES BAR AS DETERMINED BY THE DEPARTMENT, WHERE A
 16 BIOLOGICAL SURVEY SHOWS THAT THE DENSITY OF OYSTERS IS AT LEAST ONE
 17 OYSTER PER SQUARE METER.
- 18 **(3)** THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ESTABLISH AS PART OF THE PUBLIC SHELLFISH FISHERY AREA A NATURAL OYSTER BAR:
- 20 (I) THAT HAS BEEN PLANTED WITH OYSTER SHELL;
- 21 (II) THAT HAS BEEN PLANTED WITH SPAT; OR
- 22 (III) WHERE A BIOLOGICAL SURVEY SHOWS THAT THE DENSITY 23 OF OYSTERS IS AT LEAST ONE OYSTER PER SQUARE METER.
- 24 (b) The public shellfish fishery area may not be leased for shellfish aquaculture.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2018.
