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Public Health - Opioids - Dispensing Requirement

- FOR the purpose of requiring authorizing a pharmacist dispensing a drug classified as an opioid to be dispensed with a to offer to sell or distribute to the recipient a certain nontoxic composition designed to permanently and chemically sequester or deactivate the drug and be used for disposal of the drug at certain times; establishing that a certain provision of this Act does not relieve a person from certain requirements of law regarding controlled dangerous substances; and generally relating to the dispensing of opioids.
