Our open doors program welcomes all those who wish to enter: we provide financial assistance to 600-plus families in Frederick County through Y-subsidized scholarships.

To that end, the South County Family YMCA will serve youth, families, and seniors in the fastest growing part of our county. The new Ys Aquatic Center will greatly alleviate the pressure to serve 10 county swim teams in two school facilities. In addition, the Y plans to use the surplus revenue generated by this branch of the Y to underwrite critical youth and family programs in under-served, low income parts of the county. Local community needs studies have revealed a need for programs and services for Frederick Countys senior population. The results have also demonstrated the need for increased attention to the teens in our area who are subjected daily to the pressures and temptations of our modern culture. The proposed South County Family Y will feature a ; wellness center; aquatic center; group exercise studios; multi-purpose room; locker rooms; athletic fields.
