10. Description and Purpose of Organization (Limit length to visible area)

The Bender JCC is a 501(c)(3) non-profit, non-sectarian, community service agency serving the Greater DC-metro area with affordable and accessible programs and services. Our mission is to cultivate communities in an inclusive environment to celebrate Jewish life and values. We inspire individuals of all ages and backgrounds to enhance their social, physical, intellectual and spiritual well-being. We offer a wide range of educational, cultural, recreational, social and safety-net programs, and are a strong partner to other nonprofits, state and local governments in delivering needed services, education and culture. Our vision is to create enriching experiences so that people are inspired to connect to each other, Jewish culture and heritage. We make a difference every day by building community and focusing on health and wellbeing.

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

The Bender JCC, a high profile Jewish institution in our nation's capital, is a prime target for terrorists. There have been numerous attacks on JCCs and others Jewish institutions locally, nationally and worldwide. This past year, we received two bomb threats causing a full building evacuation and search. Based on law enforcement and security consultant recommendations about building access, we request funding to minimize risk, protect our facilities and those inside, by preparing against an attack with security enhancements and renovations to our front entrance vestibule and lobby. The enhancements and renovation include a Physical Access Control System "Mantrap" with two sets of interlocking doors separating entrance vestibule from lobby; blast/shock/impact resistant film for glass windows and doors; and surveillance equipment including digital cameras with additional DVRS to provide visibility at a higher resolution to entry vestibule and lobby.
