The project will consist of the following... * Constructing a state of the art 600 seat I Beam galvanized grandstand. * HVAC pressbox with a filming deck on top. * Concrete walkway with access gates. * Concrete concourse for easy mobility. * ADA observations platforms. * Railings and hand rails for safety * Black vinyl fence around perimeter for security. The project will also serve the local youth & adult recreation programs in the community.
