10. Description and Purpose of Organization (Limit length to visible area)

The mission of The Theatre, a non-profit organization, is to preserve, restore and maintain The Maryland Theatre, as a historic property and to provide quality entertainment, educational and cultural offerings to the community at large. Built in 1915, designed by renowned architect Thomas Lamb, The historic Maryland Theatre is the anchor to the Arts & Entertainment district in the city and provides comfortable seating for 1281 at performances of comedians, orchestra concerts, children's shows, musicians, recitals, stage shows, including serving as the home of the Maryland Symphony Orchestra, City Ballet Company, Barbara Ingram School for the Arts and Hagerstown Community Concert Association. The Maryland Theatre welcomes approximately 100000 people through her doors annually.

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

The Maryland Theatre is requesting support from the State of MD in order to begin construction of an expansion which will more than double available space including monthly leases for office of the MSO and rehearsal space for WCPS. Plus, offers variety of additional spaces for event rentals: small performance space, event space, rehearsal studio, which can expand programming & better support existing clients and local nonprofit programming. This programming is expected to double attendance and annual rental revenues. The flow of the possible 1,300 patrons/performance in the historic auditorium is much improved with great strides in ADA accessibility and emergency egress. Patron experience will also be improved with additional merchandise areas, concessions stands and box office accommodations.
