<p>Recipient: Anne Arundel County Maryland is a local jurisdiction in the State of Maryland serving over 550,000 residents. The Hancock's Resolution Historic Park is managed by the Anne Arundel County Department of Recreation and Parks in conjunction with the Friends of Hancock's Resolution. The Department of Recreation and Parks is responsible for the operation, management, maintenance and programming of a 17,000 acre park system. The Department also oversees the planning, design and construction of the County's park system with assistance from the Department of Public Works. Co-recipient: The co-recipient of this bond bill grant is The Friends of Hancock's Resolution a 501(C)(3) organization that currently provides management and programming of the buildings and grounds known as Hancock's Resolution.</p>				

**11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)**

This project proposes the planning, design, construction and capital equipping of a two story visitors center-barn at the Hancock's Resolution Historic Park. This structure is essential to the operation and interpretation of the 1785 homestead and grounds. The visitor center-barn will enhance the visitor experience at this 18th century tidewater farm by providing a venue to welcome and introduce visitors to the Park. The building will include an exhibit area, restrooms, offices, meeting area and stables. This project is a partnership among local and state governments and The Friends of Hancock's Resolution.
