House Bill 725 Appropriations

(Calvert County Delegation)

Calvert County - Budget Changes - Publication and Hearing Threshold

This bill updates the Public Local Laws of Calvert County to increase, from \$100,000 to \$150,000, the designated threshold under which a resolution by the Calvert County Commissioners is required to change an adopted budget after compliance with applicable publication and hearing requirements. **The bill takes effect July 1, 2018.**

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: None. Calvert County finances are not affected.

Small Business Effect: None.

Analysis

Current Law/Background: Under current law, any change to the adopted budget involving funds totaling more than \$100,000 may only be made by resolution approved by the county commissioners after compliance with the publication and hearing requirements applicable to the original proposed budget. However, even changes to the adopted budget involving amounts under \$100,000 are subject to resolution based on a separate provision of local law requiring the county commissioners to change an adopted budget via resolution.

House Bill 729 of 2018 alters the Public Local Laws of Calvert County to remove the requirement that the Calvert County Commissioners may only change an adopted budget by resolution. Instead, the county commissioners may change an adopted budget *in*

accordance with provisions of local law pertaining to changing the adopted budget, the Maryland Constitution, State law, or other local laws.
