**Baltimore City - Board of License Commissioners - License Application  
Newspaper Notice**

---

This bill requires the Baltimore City Board of License Commissioners to publish notice of an alcoholic beverages license application in two newspapers instead of three. **The bill takes effect July 1, 2018.**

---

**Fiscal Summary**

**State Effect:** None.

**Local Effect:** Baltimore City can handle the bill's requirements with existing budgeted resources.

**Small Business Effect:** None.

**Analysis**

**Current Law:** A notice of an alcoholic beverages license application must be published two times in two successive weeks in three newspapers of general circulation in Baltimore City. The notice must state:

- the name of the applicant;
  - the type of license for which the application is made;
  - the location described in the application; and
  - the date, time, and place set by the board for a hearing on the application.
