## Baltimore County - Superintendent of Schools - Prohibition on Other Employment

This bill prohibits the Baltimore County Superintendent of Schools from engaging in other employment. The bill takes effect July 1, 2018.

#### **Fiscal Summary**

**State Effect:** None.

Local Effect: The bill does not materially affect Baltimore County Public School System

finances or operations.

**Small Business Effect:** None.

## **Analysis**

**Current Law:** Generally, each county superintendent is entitled to the compensation set by the county board. The salary of a county superintendent may not be decreased during the superintendent's term of office and each county superintendent must devote full time to public school business.

**Background:** On March 8, 2018, the previous Baltimore County school superintendent pleaded guilty to four counts of perjury arising from false filings of his Financial Disclosure Statements for 2012, 2013, and 2015. The State <u>alleged</u> that the superintendent actively negotiated and later signed a no-bid contract between the school system and an outside company for which he worked.
