House Bill 1626 (I Environment and Transportation

(Delegate Stein, et al.)

Public Information Act - Motor Vehicle Administration - Warrant or Subpoena for Personal Information

This emergency bill authorizes a custodian of records for the Motor Vehicle Administration (MVA) to disclose personal information to U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement only after being provided with a valid warrant or a valid subpoena issued by a federal court or a court of this State.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: MVA can use existing resources to modify any procedures necessary to ensure compliance with the bill's provisions. No effect on revenues.

Local Effect: None.

Small Business Effect: None.

Analysis

Current Law: Subject to specified exceptions, including when required to do so by federal law, a custodian may not knowingly disclose a public record of MVA that contains personal information. However, a custodian must disclose personal information for various purposes, including for use by a federal, state, or local government, including a law enforcement agency, or a court in carrying out its functions. It must also disclose personal information for use in connection with a civil, administrative, arbitral, or a criminal proceeding in a federal, state, or local court, as specified.

"Personal information" is information that identifies an individual, including an individual's name, address, driver's license or other identification number, medical or disability information, photograph or computer-generated image, Social Security number, and telephone number.
