## 10. Description and Purpose of Organization (Limit length to visible area)

City Neighbors Charter School is a grassroots group of city neighbors including teachers, parents, business people and educators who came together to dream big for our children. We opened our doors to 120 public school children in September of 2005. City Neighbors Charter School (CNCS) is now in its thirteenth year as a Baltimore City Public Charter School. City Neighbors believes in arts integration and project-based learning, with a Reggio Emilia inspiration, cooperative governance, inclusion and diversity, and its commitment to public education. City Neighbors has grown in response to the increasing demand and size of our wait list. We now serve over 850 students K - 12 with three schools across two sites. Our mission is to serve the children of Baltimore an amazing and powerful education - getting great results for every child and family.

## 11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

In January 2017, members of our community suffered an unimaginable tragedy. The Malone Family Fire led to the loss of six of the familys nine children two of whom were students at City Neighbors Charter School. We will create a memorial playground and community park in honor of the Malone Children: Bridgette, Amelia, Zoe, Amanda, Billy and Daniel. With a theme of Magical Pathways, it will offer the community a green space of natural beauty, and will feature a winding pathway that winds its way around the entire play area creating a walkway for children and neighbors. There will be playground equipment for climbing, slides, a zipline, a swing set, and more. An outdoor stage for community gatherings and movies in the park and at the very heart and the highest elevation of the playground is a memorial garden - a circle of 6 beautiful cherry trees. This park will honor the 6 children lost in the Malone Fire, and bring hope and joy to our students and the community.

## 27. Year of Construction of Any Structures Proposed for Renovation, Restoration or Conversion 28. Comments

The Malone Children's Memorial Playground and Community Park consists of 2 sites: an existing tenniseal playground of approximately 8,171 SF and an adjacent vacant site of a former house approximately 11,250 SF, with a total combined area of 19,421 SF. The Design Team is being led by Isackson Design Group (IDG) as the Project Designer and Manager; Annapolis Landscape Architects as the Landscape Architect and Colbert Matz Rosenfelt as the Site Engineers, to produce the Concept Plan, Topography & Boundary Survey and Construction Documents needed for Permitting. Playground Equipment consultants include: Sparks At Play and Bears Playground.

All of Baltimore was impacted by this fire and loss of lives, and the generosity and good will toward all involved made national news. One such act of generosity was a donation by JP Morgan Chase of the land next to our current playspace. They razed the house on the property and deeded the land to City Neighbors for the creation of a memorial playspace in honor of the Malone Children. We have engaged the community in the design of the park, and we will work with Landscape Contractor, school leaders, community (including the Firefighters), and other stakeholders to hold a Community Build Out Day. With your support, we will continue to move forward in this important effort. The Malone Children Memorial Playground will serve the youth and families and neighbors of the Baltimore City community for many years to come as a space of learning, play and joy.
