### FISCAL AND POLICY NOTE Third Reader

House Bill 1498 Economic Matters (Delegate Lisanti, et al.)

Education, Health, and Environmental Affairs

#### Harford County - Alcoholic Beverages Licenses - Social Organization

This bill authorizes the Harford County Board of License Commissioners to issue a 6- or 7-day Class C-3 beer, wine, and liquor (BWL) license to a social organization that meets specified criteria. The bill takes effect July 1, 2018.

#### **Fiscal Summary**

State Effect: None.

**Local Effect:** Harford County revenues increase minimally as a result of additional application and license fees. Any additional enforcement activity can be handled with existing resources.

**Small Business Effect:** Minimal overall, but potential meaningful impact for a social organization that is operated for profit and qualifies as a small business.

#### Analysis

**Bill Summary:** A social organization granted a Class C-3 BWL license may sell beer, wine, and liquor on Monday through Sunday, from 4 p.m. to 11 p.m. The annual fee for the 6-day license is \$1,300, and the annual fee for the 7-day license is \$1,400.

**Current Law:** In Harford County, there is a 6-day Class C-3 BWL license and a 7-day Class C-3 BWL license, each of which may be issued to a country club, a topiary garden, or a yacht or boat club that meets specified criteria. The 6-day license authorizes the holder to sell or provide beer, wine, and liquor from Monday through Saturday for on-premises consumption by members and guests, and the 7-day license authorizes the holder to sell or

provide beer, wine, and liquor from Monday through Sunday for on-premises consumption by members and guests. The hours of sale are from 8 a.m. to 2 a.m. the following day, on the days authorized. The annual fee for the 6-day license is \$1,300, and the annual fee for the 7-day license is \$1,400.

**Background:** In fiscal 2017, 202 alcoholic beverages licenses were issued for use in Harford County, including 26 Class C BWL licenses.
