10. Description and Purpose of Organization (Limit length to visible area)

The Arc Central Chesapeake Region (The Arc CCR) serves people with disabilities and enables their families to achieve their lifes goals. The Arc CCR has a rich history of advocacy starting in 1961 by concerned parents of children with developmental disabilities. Over time it has grown to serve hundreds of individuals and their families each year. It changed its name to The Arc Central Chesapeake Region to reflect changing attitudes toward people with intellectual disabilities and to signify how The Arc CCR covers the full scope of a persons life. From early childhood to old age, each person The Arc CCR helps can find the services they need to achieve the kind of life they want to lead.

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

These funds, proposed for the planning, design, construction, repair, renovation and capital equipping of a facility on 1330 Donald Avenue, Severn. Once complete, the dramatically renovated 20,000 square-foot headquarters and professional development center will welcome community members, serve as a welcoming space for new families, those interested in services and those served. It will also include vast meeting spaces, a resource library, and a community computer lab. The space will also feature a visual history of The Arc's mission.
