AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 1273

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike “and Washington” and substitute “Washington, Atterbeary, J. Lewis, Moon, Lopez, Crutchfield, and Shetty”; strike beginning with “County” in line 2 down through “Hospitals” in line 3 and substitute “Public Schools, Hospitals, and Courthouses”; strike beginning with “county” in line 10 down through “hospitals” in line 11 and substitute “public schools, hospitals, and courthouses”; and strike in their entirety lines 12 through 21, inclusive.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, strike in their entirety lines 3 through 23, inclusive.

On pages 2 and 3, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 26 on page 2 through line 2 on page 3, inclusive, and substitute:

“(A) THE ATTORNEY GENERAL, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE APPROPRIATE STAKEHOLDERS, SHALL DEVELOP GUIDELINES TO ASSIST PUBLIC SCHOOLS, HOSPITALS, AND COURTHOUSES TO DRAFT POLICIES THAT LIMIT CIVIL IMMIGRATION ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITIES ON THEIR PREMISES IN ORDER TO ENSURE THESE FACILITIES REMAIN SAFE AND ACCESSIBLE TO ALL, REGARDLESS OF IMMIGRATION STATUS.

“(B) PUBLIC SCHOOLS, HOSPITALS, AND COURTHOUSES MAY ESTABLISH AND PUBLISH POLICIES THAT LIMIT IMMIGRATION ENFORCEMENT ON THEIR PREMISES TO THE FULLEST EXTENT POSSIBLE CONSISTENT WITH FEDERAL AND STATE LAW BASED ON THE GUIDELINES DEVELOPED BY THE ATTORNEY GENERAL.”
