- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 13 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **8–402.** 

16 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "OPIOID MAINTENANCE THERAPY PROGRAM" MEANS 17 A PROGRAM THAT USES PHARMACOLOGICAL INTERVENTIONS, INCLUDING FULL 18 AND PARTIAL OPIATE AGONIST TREATMENT MEDICATIONS, TO PROVIDE 19 TREATMENT, SUPPORT, AND RECOVERY TO OPIOID–ADDICTED INDIVIDUALS.

20 (B) AN OPIOID MAINTENANCE THERAPY PROGRAM SHALL HAVE A MEDICAL 21 DIRECTOR WHO:

22 (1) IS A PHYSICIAN; AND

1 (2) HAS 2 YEARS OF EXPERIENCE PROVIDING SERVICES TO 2 INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE ADDICTED TO ALCOHOL OR OTHER DRUGS, INCLUDING AT 3 LEAST 1 YEAR OF EXPERIENCE IN THE TREATMENT OF OPIOID ADDICTION WITH 4 OPIOID MAINTENANCE THERAPY.

5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 6 October 1, 2019.
