17 (A) THE SALES AND USE TAX DOES NOT APPLY TO THE SALE OF MATERIALS, 18 PARTS, OR EQUIPMENT USED TO REPAIR, MAINTAIN, OR UPGRADE AIRCRAFT OR THE 19 AVIONICS SYSTEMS OF AIRCRAFT IF THE MATERIALS, PARTS, OR EQUIPMENT ARE 20 INSTALLED ON THE AIRCRAFT.

(B) ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 31 EACH YEAR, THE COMPTROLLER SHALL

1 (1) THE AMOUNT OF SALES AND USE TAX REVENUE LOST FROM THE 2 EXEMPTION UNDER THIS SECTION; AND

3 (2) ANY CHANGE TO THE NUMBER OF AVIATION TECHNICIANS 4 EMPLOYED IN THE STATE AS A RESULT OF THE EXEMPTION UNDER THIS SECTION.

5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 6 1, 2019. It shall remain effective for a period of 5 years and, at the end of June 30, 2024, 7 this Act, with no further action required by the General Assembly, shall be abrogated and 8 of no further force and effect.
