BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: **Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings** SUBTITLE 22. CHANGE OF NAME – PROHIBITION OF PUBLICATION REQUIREMENT. 3-2201.
