15 **7–446.**

16 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "FEMININE HYGIENE PRODUCTS" MEANS TAMPONS 17 AND SANITARY NAPKINS FOR USE IN CONNECTION WITH THE MENSTRUAL CYCLE.

18 **(B)** A COUNTY BOARD SHALL ENSURE THAT EACH PUBLIC SCHOOL SERVING 19 STUDENTS IN ANY GRADE FROM GRADES 6 THROUGH 12 PROVIDES, AT NO CHARGE 20 TO STUDENTS, FEMININE HYGIENE PRODUCTS IN THE RESTROOMS AT THE SCHOOL.
