Motor Vehicle Administration – Licenses and Identification Cards – Electronic Credentials

- 4 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Motor Vehicle Administration to issue electronic $\mathbf{5}$ credentials to certain individuals; establishing that a credential holder satisfies 6 certain license display requirements under certain circumstances; authorizing the 7Administration to enter into agreements with certain entities to facilitate the issuance, use, or verification of certain electronic credentials; authorizing the 8 9 Administration to create a certain electronic credential; requiring the 10 Administration to design the electronic credential in a certain manner; authorizing 11 the Administration to operate a certain verification system; requiring a credential 12holder's consent in order for a certain person to access the verification system and 13 certain information; specifying the information that may be released through the 14 verification system; authorizing a third party to administer certain systems on 15behalf of the Administration; authorizing the Administration to charge certain fees; 16 authorizing the Administration to adopt certain regulations; authorizing an alcoholic 17beverages license holder or an employee of the license holder to accept an individual's 18 electronic credential as proof of the individual's age; defining certain terms; altering 19 certain definitions; and generally relating to licenses, identification cards, and the 20issuance of electronic credentials.

15 **(B)** "CREDENTIAL HOLDER" MEANS THE INDIVIDUAL TO WHOM AN 16 ELECTRONIC CREDENTIAL IS ISSUED.

17 (C) "DATA FIELD" MEANS A DISCRETE PIECE OF INFORMATION PRINTED OR 18 OTHERWISE APPEARING ON A LICENSE OR AN IDENTIFICATION CARD.

19(D) "ELECTRONICCREDENTIAL" MEANSANELECTRONIC20REPRESENTATION OF A LICENSE, AN IDENTIFICATION CARD, OR A DATA FIELD.

21 (E) "FULL PROFILE" MEANS ALL THE INFORMATION PROVIDED ON A 22 LICENSE OR AN IDENTIFICATION CARD.

23 (F) "LIMITED PROFILE" MEANS A PORTION OF THE INFORMATION 24 PROVIDED ON A LICENSE OR AN IDENTIFICATION CARD.

1 (B) THE ADMINISTRATION MAY ENTER INTO AGREEMENTS WITH AN 2 AGENCY OF THE STATE, ANOTHER STATE, OR THE UNITED STATES TO FACILITATE 3 THE ISSUANCE, USE, AND VERIFICATION OF ELECTRONIC CREDENTIALS ISSUED BY 4 THE ADMINISTRATION OR ANOTHER STATE.

5 (C) THE ADMINISTRATION MAY CREATE AN ELECTRONIC CREDENTIAL 6 THAT:

7 (1) IS CAPABLE OF PRODUCING BOTH A FULL PROFILE AND A LIMITED 8 PROFILE; AND

9 (2) SATISFIES THE PURPOSE FOR WHICH THE PROFILE IS BEING 10 PRESENTED.

(D) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL DESIGN THE ELECTRONIC CREDENTIAL
 IN A MANNER THAT ALLOWS THE CREDENTIAL HOLDER TO MAINTAIN PHYSICAL
 POSSESSION OF THE DEVICE ON WHICH THE ELECTRONIC CREDENTIAL IS ACCESSED
 DURING VERIFICATION.

16 (A) THE ADMINISTRATION MAY OPERATE A VERIFICATION SYSTEM FOR 17 ELECTRONIC CREDENTIALS.

18 **(B) (1)** ACCESS TO THE VERIFICATION SYSTEM AND ANY DATA FIELD BY A 19 PERSON PRESENTED WITH AN ELECTRONIC CREDENTIAL REQUIRES THE 20 CREDENTIAL HOLDER'S CONSENT.

21 (2) IF CONSENT IS GRANTED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS 22 SUBSECTION, THE ADMINISTRATION MAY RELEASE THROUGH THE VERIFICATION 23 SYSTEM:

24(I)FOR A FULL PROFILE, ALL DATA FIELDS THAT APPEAR ON25THE PHYSICAL CREDENTIAL THAT CORRESPONDS WITH THE ELECTRONIC26CREDENTIAL THAT IS BEING VERIFIED; AND

(II) FOR A LIMITED PROFILE, ONLY THE DATA FIELDS
 REPRESENTED IN THE LIMITED PROFILE FOR THE PHYSICAL CREDENTIAL THAT
 CORRESPONDS WITH THE ELECTRONIC CREDENTIAL THAT IS BEING VERIFIED.

30 (C) A THIRD PARTY MAY ADMINISTER ON BEHALF OF THE ADMINISTRATION 31 ANY SYSTEM DEVELOPED TO FACILITATE THE ISSUANCE, VERIFICATION, AND USE 32 OF ELECTRONIC CREDENTIALS.
