Wicomico County - Alcoholic Beverages - Bed and Breakfast License

3 FOR the purpose of establishing a Class B-BB (bed and breakfast) beer and wine license in Wicomico County; providing the qualifications that must be met for issuance of 4 5 the license; authorizing the license holder to sell alcoholic beverages to guests of the 6 establishment under certain circumstances; authorizing the license holder to sell 7 alcoholic beverages to guests of certain catered events under certain circumstances; 8 authorizing the license holder to allow certain guests to consume personal alcoholic 9 beverages on the premises under certain circumstances and subject to a certain limitation; specifying the hours of sale of alcoholic beverages; specifying that, except 10 11 during certain catered events or ticketed events hosted by the license holder, the 12 license does not authorize the license holder to sell alcoholic beverages to certain 13 individuals; specifying that a license is void under certain circumstances and must 14 be returned to the Board of License Commissioners for Wicomico County; specifying 15 that certain restrictions do not apply to a permanent resident of the establishment 16 or to guests of the permanent resident; requiring the license holder to retain and 17 make available certain records; setting an annual fee for the license; and generally 18 relating to alcoholic beverages licenses in Wicomico County.
