1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Department of the Environment – SepticSmart Week in Montgomery County**

3 **MC 17–19**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of the Environment to establish a certain
5 period of time as SepticSmart Week in Montgomery County; requiring the
6 Department to use certain educational materials and other resources to promote
7 community awareness regarding the proper use and maintenance of on–site sewage
8 disposal systems and certain impacts of proper design, installation, operation, and
9 maintenance of on–site sewage disposal systems; and generally relating to on–site
10 sewage disposal systems in Montgomery County.

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
17 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 **Article – Environment**

19 **9–1113.**

1 (A) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ESTABLISH THE THIRD WEEK IN SEPTEMBER
2 AS SEPTICSMART WEEK IN MONTGOMERY COUNTY.

3 (B) DURING SEPTICSMART WEEK, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL USE THE
4 EDUCATIONAL MATERIALS PROVIDED UNDER THE U.S. ENVIRONMENTAL
5 PROTECTION AGENCY’S SEPTICSMART INITIATIVE AND OTHER RESOURCES TO
6 PROMOTE COMMUNITY AWARENESS REGARDING:

7 (1) THE PROPER USE AND MAINTENANCE OF ON-SITE SEWAGE
8 DISPOSAL SYSTEMS; AND

9 (2) THE IMPACT OF PROPER DESIGN, INSTALLATION, OPERATION,
10 AND MAINTENANCE OF ON-SITE SEWAGE DISPOSAL SYSTEMS ON:

11 (I) PRESERVING SURFACE AND UNDERGROUND WATERS;

12 (II) PROTECTING PUBLIC HEALTH; AND

13 (III) AVOIDING COSTLY REPAIRS.

14 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
15 October 1, 2019.
