1 AN ACT concerning

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Frederick County - Alcoholic Beverages - Cinema/Theater License

3 FOR the purpose of creating a cinema/theater license in Frederick County; authorizing the 4 Board of License Commissioners to issue the license for use in a for-profit cinema or 5 theater that has one or more screening rooms or performance halls; authorizing the 6 license holder to sell beer, wine, and liquor for on-premises consumption under 7 certain circumstances; requiring a license holder to sell certain food; authorizing a 8 customer to consume beer, wine, or liquor anywhere on the licensed premises; 9 prohibiting an individual serving beer, wine, or liquor from mixing the contents of 10 one bottle with the contents of another bottle; requiring the individual to dispose of 11 or destroy all empty bottles and cans; requiring a license holder to obtain a certain crowd control training certificate and have a certain certified crowd control manager 12 13 present at the licensed premises at certain times; requiring the license holder to have 14 a certain individual who has received certification from a certain alcohol awareness 15 program to be present at the licensed premises under certain circumstances; specifying a license fee; repealing a provision of law concerning Class B-DH 16 17 (drafthouse) licenses for theaters; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages 18 licenses in Frederick County.

19	(H) THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEE IS \$1,500.
