1 AN ACT concerning

Public Health - Sale or Distribution of Trichloroethylene - Prohibition

- FOR the purpose of prohibiting, on or after a certain date, a person from selling or distributing in commerce an aerosol degreaser or a spot cleaner for dry cleaning that contains trichloroethylene; establishing a certain penalty for a certain violation; and generally relating to a prohibition on the sale or distribution of products containing trichloroethylene.

- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 17 (A) ON OR AFTER JANUARY 1, 2021, A PERSON MAY NOT SELL OR
- 18 DISTRIBUTE IN COMMERCE ANY COMMERCIAL OR CONSUMER AEROSOL DEGREASER
- 19 OR A SPOT CLEANER FOR DRY CLEANING THAT CONTAINS TRICHLOROETHYLENE
- 20 **(TCE).**
- 21 (B) A PERSON THAT VIOLATES THIS SECTION OR ANY REGULATION
- 22 ADOPTED BY THE SECRETARY TO CARRY OUT THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A
- 23 MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000

1 FOR EACH VIOLATION.
