3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Board of License Commissioners for Dorchester County

6 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 7 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

8 **Article – Alcoholic Beverages**

9 19–102.

10 This title applies only in Dorchester County.

11 19–1604.

12 (a) The Board may issue a Class A beer license [or], ~~▲~~ Class A beer and wine
 13 license, **OR ▲ CLASS A BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR LICENSE** for a premises licensed under
 14 a Class B or Class D license.

15 (b) The Board may limit the number of Class A beer licenses [and], Class A beer
 16 and wine licenses, **AND CLASS A BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR LICENSES** that the Board
 17 issues.

18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
 19 1, 2019.
