- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 13 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 Article - Health - General

- 16 (A) [A] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, A person
- 17 may not directly or indirectly advertise for or solicit business in this State for any medical
- 18 laboratory, regardless of location, from anyone except a physician, hospital, medical
- 19 laboratory, clinic, clinical installation, or other medical care facility.

- 22 PHYSICIAN AND PERFORMED BY A MEDICAL LABORATORY CERTIFIED UNDER 42
- 23 U.S.C. § 263A.
