

- 17 (2)The EITHER THE license holder OR THE EVENT SPONSOR shall provide food for consumption at the catered event. 18
- 19 The license holder may sell beer, wine, and liquor during the hours and on the 20 days as set out for a Class B license under § 16–2005 of this title.
- 21(e) The annual license fee is \$250 greater than the fee for a Class B hotel or 22restaurant (on– and off–sale) beer, wine, and liquor license.
- 23 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 241, 2019.
