
- 4 FOR the purpose of providing that the authorization for a county board of education to 5 extend the length of the school year for a certain number of days beyond a certain 6 date without approval from the State Board of Education does not apply to the 7 Howard County Board of Education; requiring the Howard County Board of 8 Education to set the start date and end date of the school year for the public schools 9 in the county each year; making conforming changes; and generally relating to the 10 start date and end date of the school year and the Howard County Board of 11 Education.

- (D) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW AND SUBJECT TO THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION, THE HOWARD COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION SHALL SET THE START DATE AND END DATE OF THE SCHOOL YEAR FOR THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS IN THE COUNTY EACH YEAR.
- [(d)] (E) Except as provided in subsection [(e)] (F) of this section, the State Board shall divide the school year into the terms it considers appropriate.
- [(e)] (F) (1) The county boards of Allegany, Anne Arundel, Calvert, Howard, Montgomery, and Prince George's counties, and the Board of School Commissioners of Baltimore City, may elect to operate one or more schools within the county or Baltimore City on a year—round basis, provided that the 180—day and the minimum hour requirements under this section are met.
- 17 (2) Nothing in this section precludes a county board from conducting a 18 year—round pilot study or program that is funded by the county board.
- 19 **[(f)] (G)** Publicly funded prekindergarten programs are not subject to the 20 requirements of subsection (a) of this section.
- 21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 22 1, 2019.
