CHAPTER

- 1 AN ACT concerning
- 2 State Board of Physicians Sunset Evaluation and Performance Audit
- 3 FOR the purpose of altering the date of a certain evaluation provision relating to the State
- 4 Board of Physicians under the Maryland Program Evaluation Act (Sunset Law);
- 5 requiring the Office of Legislative Audits to conduct a certain performance audit of
- 6 the State Board of Physicians; requiring the Office of Legislative Audits to report to
- 7 the General Assembly on or before a certain date; making a conforming change; and
- 8 generally relating to the State Board of Physicians.
- 9 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND.
- 15 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 16 Article State Government
- 17 8–405.

- 4 (5) Physicians, State Board of (§ 14–201 of the Health Occupations Article: 5 [2021] **2019**), [including] AND:
- 6 (i) Athletic Training Advisory Committee (§ 14–5D–04 of the Health 7 Occupations Article: 2021);
- 8 (ii) Naturopathic Medicine Advisory Committee (§ 14–5F–04 of the 9 Health Occupations Article: 2021);
- 10 (iii) Perfusion Advisory Committee (§ 14–5E–05 of the Health 11 Occupations Article: 2021);
- 12 (iv) Physician Assistant Advisory Committee (§ 15–201 of the Health 13 Occupations Article: 2021);
- 14 (v) Polysomnography Professional Standards Committee 15 (§ 14–5C–05 of the Health Occupations Article: 2021);
- 16 (vi) Radiation Therapy, Radiography, Nuclear Medicine Technology 17 Advisory, and Radiology Assistance Committee (§ 14–5B–05 of the Health Occupations 18 Article: 2021); and
- 19 (vii) Respiratory Care Professional Standards Committee 20 (§ 14–5A–05 of the Health Occupations Article: 2021).
- 21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That:
- 22 (a) The Office of Legislative Audits shall conduct a performance audit of the State 23 Board of Physicians to evaluate whether the Board is operating in an economic, efficient, 24 and effective manner.
- 25 (b) On or before January 1, 2020, the Office of Legislative Audits shall report to the General Assembly, in accordance with § 2–1246 of the State Government Article, on the audit of the State Board of Physicians.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2019.
