Maryland Longitudinal Data System – Student Data and Governing Board				
FOR the purpose of altering the types of records included in and excluded from the definition of "student data" for purposes of the Maryland Longitudinal Data System; adding the Department of Juvenile Services to the entities required to provide data sets to the Maryland Longitudinal Data System; adding the Secretary of Juvenile Services or a certain designee to the governing board of the Maryland Longitudinal Data System Center; altering the type of data certain entities are required to transfer to the Maryland Longitudinal Data System; and generally relating to the Maryland Longitudinal Data System.
