- WHEREAS, On December 19, 2011, the United Nations General Assembly adopted Resolution 66/170 to declare October 11 each year as the International Day of the Girl to recognize girls' rights and the unique challenges girls face around the world; and
- WHEREAS, The International Day of the Girl publicly recognizes the vulnerable positions of girls worldwide and endorses their protection and promotion as equal citizens in every country; and
- WHEREAS, In various countries, girls do not have the right of free speech or enjoy



- privileges afforded others in their respective societies, are exploited and attacked, and are subjected to media pressure concerning how they should look, act, and feel; and
- WHEREAS, The observation of the International Day of the Girl supports more opportunity for girls and increases awareness of gender inequality faced by girls worldwide based on their gender; and
- WHEREAS, The observance of the International Day of the Girl in Maryland may help build awareness of the challenges faced by girls worldwide and promote the end of gender discrimination; now, therefore,
- 9 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 10 That Section(s) 7–415 through 7–417, respectively, of Article – General Provisions of the
- 11 Annotated Code of Maryland be renumbered to be Section(s) 7-416 through 7-418,
- 12 respectively.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 17 (A) THE GOVERNOR ANNUALLY SHALL PROCLAIM OCTOBER 11 AS 18 INTERNATIONAL DAY OF THE GIRL.
- 19 **(B)** THE PROCLAMATION SHALL URGE EDUCATIONAL AND CULTURAL 20 ORGANIZATIONS TO OBSERVE THE INTERNATIONAL DAY OF THE GIRL PROPERLY.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2019.
