- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Motor Vehicle Administration to develop and issue special registration plates for honorably discharged veterans of all branches of the armed 4 forces of the United States; specifying who may apply and the classes of vehicles 5 6 eligible for the special registration plates; establishing the manner in which certain 7 fees will be established, retained, and credited in connection with the special 8 registration plates; specifying the contents of the special registration plates; 9 requiring the Administration to adopt certain regulations; altering the composition of the Maryland Veterans Trust Fund; and generally relating to the issuance of 10 special registration plates for honorably discharged veterans of all branches of the 11 armed forces of the United States charge a certain additional fee on the issuance of 12 13 special registration plates for recipients of an individually earned, combat-related, armed forces medal; requiring that the additional fee under this Act be credited to 14 the Maryland Veterans Trust Fund; and generally relating to the fees charged for 15 16 certain special registration plates for veterans.
