- 1 (19) Authorizing a person to cross a highway on an all-terrain vehicle at a 2 right angle to access a farm or to move from one part of a farm to another part of the same 3 farm; AND
- 4 (20) IN THE TOWN OF NORTH BEACH, CALVERT COUNTY, 5 AUTHORIZING THE OPERATION OF GOLF CARTS OR ROBOTIC DELIVERY DEVICES ON 6 MUNICIPAL HIGHWAYS.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June $8\,\,$ 1, 2019.
