- 12 UNLESS EXPRESSLY AUTHORIZED BY FEDERAL OR STATE LAW, THE 13 GOVERNING BODY OF A COUNTY OR MUNICIPALITY MAY NOT ENACT A LOCAL LAW THAT RESTRICTS OR PROHIBITS THE TRANSPORTATION OF AN ANIMAL FOR 14 EDUCATION, EXHIBITION, COMPETITION, OR ENTERTAINMENT PURPOSES. 15
- IN THE EVENT OF A CONFLICT BETWEEN THE APPLICATION OF THIS 16 17 SECTION AND ANY FEDERAL OR STATE LAW REGARDING ANIMAL CARE OR PUBLIC HEALTH AND SAFETY, THE PROVISIONS OF THE FEDERAL OR STATE LAW SHALL 18 19 CONTROL.
- 20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 21 October 1, 2019.
