A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Vehicle Emissions Inspection Program – Extension – Out-of-State Students**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring that the inspection and testing deadline be extended for a
4 vehicle owned or driven primarily by a certain student; prohibiting an extension from
5 being granted if the extension is prohibited by federal law; requiring that the
6 inspection and testing deadline be extended to certain time frames for certain
7 students; establishing the qualifications for an extension; requiring certain
8 information to be submitted to the Motor Vehicle Administration in a certain
9 manner; requiring the Administration to waive certain late fees under certain
10 circumstances; and generally relating to the vehicle emissions inspection program.

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
17 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 **Article – Transportation**

19 **23–206.3.**

20 **(A) (1) SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE**
21 **INSPECTION AND TESTING DEADLINE FOR A MOTOR VEHICLE OWNED OR DRIVEN**
22 **PRIMARILY BY AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS A STUDENT ENROLLED IN AN OUT-OF-STATE**
23 **SCHOOL, OUT-OF-STATE SUMMER EDUCATION PROGRAM, OR OUT-OF-STATE**
24 **SUMMER VOLUNTEER PROGRAM SHALL BE EXTENDED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS**
25 **SECTION.**

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.



1 **(2) AN EXTENSION UNDER THIS SECTION MAY NOT BE GRANTED IF**
2 **THE EXTENSION IS PROHIBITED BY FEDERAL LAW.**

3 **(B) AN EXTENSION UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL EXTEND THE INSPECTION**
4 **AND TESTING DEADLINE TO BETWEEN:**

5 **(1) FOR AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS ENROLLED IN AN OUT-OF-STATE**
6 **SCHOOL, THE FOLLOWING JUNE 1 AND JULY 31 AFTER THE INDIVIDUAL RECEIVES**
7 **NOTICE OF THE INSPECTION;**

8 **(2) FOR AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS ENROLLED IN AN OUT-OF-STATE**
9 **SUMMER EDUCATION PROGRAM OR AN OUT-OF-STATE SUMMER VOLUNTEER**
10 **PROGRAM, THE FOLLOWING DECEMBER 1 AND JANUARY 31 AFTER THE INDIVIDUAL**
11 **RECEIVES NOTICE OF THE INSPECTION; AND**

12 **(3) FOR AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS ENROLLED IN AN OUT-OF-STATE**
13 **SCHOOL AND AN OUT-OF-STATE SUMMER EDUCATION PROGRAM OR AN**
14 **OUT-OF-STATE SUMMER VOLUNTEER PROGRAM, THE FOLLOWING DECEMBER 1**
15 **AND JANUARY 31 AFTER THE INDIVIDUAL RECEIVES NOTICE OF THE INSPECTION.**

16 **(C) (1) IN ORDER TO QUALIFY FOR AN EXTENSION UNDER THIS SECTION,**
17 **THE OWNER OR PRIMARY DRIVER OF THE MOTOR VEHICLE SHALL:**

18 **(I) CERTIFY THAT THE INDIVIDUAL IS THE OWNER OR PRIMARY**
19 **DRIVER OF THE MOTOR VEHICLE;**

20 **(II) PROVIDE TO THE ADMINISTRATION A COPY OF THE**
21 **CURRENT INSURANCE POLICY FOR THE MOTOR VEHICLE THAT IDENTIFIES THE**
22 **INDIVIDUAL AS THE OWNER OR PRIMARY DRIVER OF THE MOTOR VEHICLE;**

23 **(III) CERTIFY THAT THE INDIVIDUAL IS CURRENTLY ENROLLED**
24 **IN AN OUT-OF-STATE SCHOOL, OUT-OF-STATE SUMMER EDUCATION PROGRAM, OR**
25 **OUT-OF-STATE SUMMER VOLUNTEER PROGRAM; AND**

26 **(IV) CERTIFY THAT THE MOTOR VEHICLE:**

27 **1. IS OR WILL BE OUTSIDE THE STATE WITH THE**
28 **INDIVIDUAL WHEN THE MOTOR VEHICLE IS SCHEDULED TO BE INSPECTED; OR**

29 **2. IS NOT BEING DRIVEN REGULARLY WHILE THE**
30 **INDIVIDUAL IS OUTSIDE THE STATE.**

1 **(2) THE INFORMATION REQUIRED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION MUST BE**
2 **SUBMITTED TO THE ADMINISTRATION IN A MANNER DETERMINED BY THE**
3 **ADMINISTRATION.**

4 **(D) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL WAIVE ANY LATE FEES INCURRED FOR**
5 **FAILURE TO HAVE A MOTOR VEHICLE INSPECTED AND TESTED IF THE OWNER OR**
6 **PRIMARY DRIVER OF THE MOTOR VEHICLE:**

7 **(1) IS A STUDENT ENROLLED IN AN OUT-OF-STATE SCHOOL,**
8 **OUT-OF-STATE SUMMER EDUCATION PROGRAM, OR OUT-OF-STATE SUMMER**
9 **VOLUNTEER PROGRAM; AND**

10 **(2) HAS THE MOTOR VEHICLE INSPECTED AND TESTED WITHIN 60**
11 **DAYS OF THE FIRST LATE NOTICE.**

12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June
13 1, 2019.
