A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

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Behavioral Health Transformation Act of 2019

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Maryland Department of Health to establish a delivery 4 system for certain specialty behavioral health services, rather than for only specialty 5 mental health services, for enrollees of managed care organizations; requiring the 6 delivery system to assume certain financial risk; requiring the delivery system to 7 provide certain services to certain individuals; requiring the delivery system to 8 provide a certain point of contact and certain processes, reimburse certain providers, 9 measure and collect certain data, report on certain outcomes, provide coordination with certain entities, manage certain processes, comply with certain laws, and 10 11 ensure opportunities for stakeholder involvement in certain matters; authorizing the 12 Department to contract with a certain managed care organization for delivery of 13 certain specialty behavioral health services under certain circumstances; providing 14 that a certain provision of law applies to the delivery system; requiring the Secretary 15 of Health to modify and reissue a certain request for proposals to incorporate this 16 Act; making conforming changes; defining certain terms; and generally relating to a 17 delivery system for specialty behavioral health services.

25 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Secretary of Health shall modify and reissue Request for Proposals No. MDH/OPASS 20-18319, issued November 26 29, 2018, and entitled "Administrative Services Organization for Maryland's Public 27 Behavioral Health System", to incorporate the provisions of Section 1 of this Act. 28

29 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2019. 30
