CHAPTER _____

1 AN ACT concerning

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Vehicle Laws – Electric Bicycles – Equipment and Operation

3 FOR the purpose of establishing certain classes of electric bicycles; clarifying that electric 4 bicycles are not included in the definition of "off-highway recreational vehicle"; $\mathbf{5}$ establishing that electric bicycles may be operated in any place where bicycles are 6 allowed to travel, subject to certain restrictions; prohibiting a person under a certain 7 age from operating a certain electric bicycle on a public highway; authorizing a 8 person under a certain age to ride as a passenger on a certain electric bicycle under 9 certain circumstances; requiring manufacturers and distributors to apply a certain 10 label in a certain manner to electric bicycles beginning on a certain date; prohibiting 11 a person from tampering with or modifying an electric bicycle in a certain manner 12under certain circumstances; requiring electric bicycles to comply with certain 13 federal regulations governing bicycle equipment and manufacturing; requiring the 14 electric motor of an electric bicycle to disengage or cease to function under certain 15circumstances; requiring certain electric bicycles to be equipped with a speedometer; altering certain definitions; and generally relating to equipment for and the 16 17operation of electric bicycles.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 6 $\overline{7}$ That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 8 **Article – Transportation** 9 11 - 117.1.10 (A) "Electric bicycle" means a vehicle that: 11 (1)Is designed to be operated by human power with the assistance of an 12electric motor; 13 (2)Is equipped with fully operable pedals; 14 (3)Has two or three wheels; 15(4) Has a motor with a rating of [500] 750 watts or less; and 16 Is capable of a maximum speed of 20 miles per hour on a level surface (5)when powered by the motor] MEETS ONE OF THE REQUIREMENTS OF SUBSECTION (B) 1718 OF THIS SECTION. 19 A CLASS 1 ELECTRIC BICYCLE IS EQUIPPED WITH A MOTOR THAT **(B)** (1) 20PROVIDES ASSISTANCE ONLY WHEN THE RIDER IS PEDALING AND CEASES TO 21PROVIDE ASSISTANCE WHEN THE BICYCLE REACHES A SPEED OF 20 MILES PER 22HOUR. 23(2) A CLASS 2 ELECTRIC BICYCLE IS EQUIPPED WITH A MOTOR THAT PROVIDES ASSISTANCE WHETHER OR NOT THE RIDER IS PEDALING THE BICYCLE 2425AND CEASES TO PROVIDE ASSISTANCE WHEN THE BICYCLE REACHES A SPEED OF 20 26MILES PER HOUR. 27A CLASS 3 ELECTRIC BICYCLE IS EQUIPPED WITH A MOTOR THAT (3) 28PROVIDES ASSISTANCE ONLY WHEN THE RIDER IS PEDALING AND CEASES TO 29PROVIDE ASSISTANCE WHEN THE BICYCLE REACHES A SPEED OF 28 MILES PER 30 HOUR. 3111 - 140.1.32 (b) "Off-highway recreational vehicle" does not include:

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1 (1) A farm vehicle as defined in § 13–911 of this article when used 2 exclusively on farm property by a farmer; [or]

3 (2) Any vehicle when used on residential property for the purpose of 4 landscaping, gardening, or lawn care; **OR**

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(3) AN ELECTRIC BICYCLE.

7 (A) (1) SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, ELECTRIC 8 BICYCLES MAY BE OPERATED WHERE BICYCLES ARE ALLOWED TO TRAVEL, 9 INCLUDING BIKE LANES.

10 (2) (I) A LOCAL AUTHORITY OR STATE AGENCY THAT HAS 11 JURISDICTION OVER A BICYCLE PATH MAY PROHIBIT THE OPERATION OF A CLASS 1 12 OR CLASS 2 ELECTRIC BICYCLE ON THE BICYCLE PATH.

13(II)A CLASS 3 ELECTRIC BICYCLE MAY NOT BE OPERATED ON A14BICYCLE PATH UNLESS:

15 **1.** The bicycle path is within or adjacent to a 16 Highway Right-of-way; or

17 2. ALLOWED BY A LOCAL AUTHORITY OR STATE AGENCY
18 WITH JURISDICTION OVER THE BICYCLE PATH.

19 (III) A LOCAL AUTHORITY OR STATE AGENCY WITH 20 JURISDICTION OVER A TRAIL MAY REGULATE THE USE OF ELECTRIC BICYCLES OF 21 ANY CLASS ON A TRAIL DESIGNATED AS NONMOTORIZED IF THE TRAIL HAS A 22 NATURAL SURFACE TREAD MADE BY CLEARING AND GRADING NATIVE SOIL WITH NO 23 ADDED SURFACING MATERIALS.

24 (B) (1) A PERSON UNDER THE AGE OF 16 YEARS MAY NOT OPERATE A 25 CLASS 3 ELECTRIC BICYCLE <u>ON A PUBLIC HIGHWAY</u>.

26 (2) A PERSON UNDER THE AGE OF 16 YEARS MAY RIDE AS A 27 PASSENGER ON A CLASS 3 ELECTRIC BICYCLE THAT IS DESIGNED TO ACCOMMODATE 28 PASSENGERS.

- 6 (I) THE CLASSIFICATION;
- 7 (II) THE TOP ASSISTED SPEED; AND
- 8 (III) THE MOTOR WATTAGE.

9 (B) A PERSON MAY NOT TAMPER WITH OR MODIFY AN ELECTRIC BICYCLE IN 10 A MANNER THAT CHANGES THE MOTOR-POWERED SPEED CAPABILITY OF THE 11 ELECTRIC BICYCLE UNLESS THE PERSON CORRECTS THE CLASSIFICATION ON THE 12 LABEL REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION.

13 (C) AN ELECTRIC BICYCLE SHALL COMPLY WITH THE EQUIPMENT AND 14 MANUFACTURING REQUIREMENTS FOR BICYCLES ADOPTED BY THE FEDERAL 15 CONSUMER PRODUCT SAFETY COMMISSION UNDER 16 C.F.R. § 1512.

16 **(D) (1)** AN ELECTRIC BICYCLE SHALL OPERATE IN A MANNER SO THAT 17 THE ELECTRIC MOTOR IS DISENGAGED OR CEASES TO FUNCTION:

 23 WHEN THE OPERATOR STOPS PEDALING.

24 (E) A CLASS 3 ELECTRIC BICYCLE SHALL BE EQUIPPED WITH A 25 SPEEDOMETER THAT DISPLAYS THE SPEED OF THE ELECTRIC BICYCLE IN MILES PER 26 HOUR.

27 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 28 October 1, 2019.
