## CHAPTER \_\_\_\_\_

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **St. Mary's County – Alcoholic Beverages – Class C Per Diem Licenses**

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing in St. Mary's County a Class C per diem license holder to  
4 hold another license of a different class or nature; and generally relating to alcoholic  
5 beverages licenses in St. Mary's County.

6 BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments,

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
17 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 **Article – Alcoholic Beverages**

3 (a) There is:

4 (1) a Class C per diem beer license;

5 (2) a Class C per diem beer and wine license; and

6 (3) a Class C per diem beer, wine, and liquor license.

7 (b) The Board may:

8 (1) issue a license to a:

9 (i) religious, fraternal, civic, veterans', or charitable organization,  
10 association, club, or society; or

11 (ii) hospital supporting organization; and

12 (2) impose conditions on the license.

13 (c) The period for which a license under this section may be issued is:

14 (1) for a Class C per diem beer license, not longer than 10 days;

15 (2) for a Class C per diem beer and wine license, 1 day; and

16 (3) for a Class C per diem beer, wine, and liquor license, 1 day.

17 (d) A license holder may purchase the alcoholic beverages to be sold under the  
18 license from a retail dealer.

19 **(E) THE LICENSE HOLDER MAY HOLD ANOTHER LICENSE OF A DIFFERENT**  
20 **CLASS OR NATURE.**

21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July  
22 1, 2019.
