A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

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State Prescription Drug Benefits - Retiree Benefits - Alterations

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the State to continue providing a certain State prescription 4 drug benefit plan to certain retirees; authorizing certain retirees who participate in 5 a certain prescription drug benefit plan with a spouse or dependent child to elect to 6 have the spouse or dependent child covered under a certain State prescription drug 7 benefit plan; authorizing certain surviving spouses and surviving dependent 8 children to elect to enroll in a certain State prescription drug benefit plan; 9 authorizing the State to include a certain prescription drug benefit plan in the health insurance benefit options established under the State Employee and Retiree Health 10 11 and Welfare Benefits Program for certain retirees; altering the date by which the 12 Secretary of Budget and Management is required to provide a certain notice to 13 certain individuals; altering the information required to be included in a certain notice to certain individuals; making conforming changes; and generally relating to 14 15 retirees from State employment and participation in the State prescription drug 16 benefit plan.

- 22 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

13 14 15 16 17 18	(2) [Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, the] THE State shall continue to include a prescription drug benefit plan in the health insurance benefit options established under the Program and available to retirees under §§ 2–508 and 2–509 of this subtitle notwithstanding the enactment of the federal Medicare Prescription Drug, Improvement, and Modernization Act of 2003 or any other federal law permitting states to discontinue prescription drug benefit plans to retirees of a state.

22 23 24 25 26	(4) If a surviving spouse or surviving dependent child of a retiree is eligible to enroll in the State prescription drug benefit plan under § 2–508 or § 2–509 of this subtitle, the surviving spouse or surviving dependent child may elect to enroll in the State prescription drug benefit plan.
27 28 29 30	(b) [Except as provided in subsection (c) of this section, on January 1, 2019, the] THE State [shall discontinue] MAY INCLUDE A prescription drug [benefits] BENEFIT PLAN IN THE HEALTH INSURANCE BENEFIT OPTIONS ESTABLISHED UNDER THE PROGRAM for:
31	(1) a Medicare–eligible retiree;

the Medicare–eligible spouse or surviving spouse of a retiree; and

(3) a Medicare-eligible dependent child or surviving dependent child of a 1 2 retiree. 3 If a retiree is eligible to participate in the prescription drug benefit plan (c) (1)4 under Medicare, but the retiree's spouse or dependent child is not eligible to participate in 5 a Medicare prescription drug benefit plan, the retiree may elect to cover the retiree's spouse 6 or dependent child under the State prescription drug benefit plan. 7 If the surviving spouse or surviving dependent child of a retiree is 8 eligible to enroll in the State prescription drug benefit plan under § 2–509 of this subtitle, 9 but is not eligible to participate in the prescription drug benefit plan under Medicare, the 10 surviving spouse or surviving dependent child may elect to enroll in the State prescription 11 drug benefit plan. 12 (d) Subject to paragraph (2) of this subsection, not **NOT** later than July 1, 13 [2018] **2019**, the Secretary shall provide written certified notice to the individuals listed in subsection (b) of this section of [the change] ANY CHANGES in the State prescription drug 14 15 benefit plan under this section. 16 The notice shall include information regarding: (2)17 (i) coverage options available in the Medicare prescription drug 18 benefit plan; and 19 (ii) the potential for significant penalties if an individual does not 20 promptly choose a Medicare prescription drug benefit plan immediately on termination of 21the individual's participation in the State prescription drug benefit plan. 22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June

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1, 2019.
