4 FOR the purpose of establishing the Task Force to Study Admission Practices at Public 5 Senior Higher Education Institutions; providing for the composition, chair, and 6 staffing of the Task Force; prohibiting a member of the Task Force from receiving 7 certain compensation, but authorizing the reimbursement of certain expenses; 8 requiring the Task Force to study and make recommendations regarding certain 9 matters; requiring the Task Force to report its findings and recommendations to the Governor and the General Assembly on or before a certain date; providing for the 10 11 termination of this Act; and generally relating to the Task Force to Study Admission 12 Practices at Public Senior Higher Education Institutions.


- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 14 That:
- 15 (a) There is a Task Force to Study Admission Practices at Public Senior Higher 16 Education Institutions.
- 17 (b) The Task Force consists of the following members:
- 18 (1) one member of the Senate of Maryland, appointed by the President of 19 the Senate:
- 20 (2) one member of the House of Delegates, appointed by the Speaker of the 21 House:
- 22 (3) the Secretary of Higher Education, or the Secretary's designee; and
- 23 (4) the following members, appointed by the Secretary of Higher 24 Education:

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2019. It shall remain effective for a period of 1 year and, at the end of June 30, 2020, this
