3 FOR the purpose of ~~requiring the director of the Asthma Control Program in the Maryland~~
4 ~~Department of Health to establish the Breathe Easy Pilot Program in cooperation~~
5 ~~and consultation with certain entities~~ establishing the Breathe Easy East Baltimore
6 Pilot Program in the Baltimore City Health Department; providing for the purpose
7 of the Pilot Program; requiring the ~~director~~ Baltimore City Health Department, in
8 consultation with a certain entity, to select, on or before a certain date, certain
9 households to participate in the Pilot Program, to provide certain households with
10 certain asthma remediation services, and to study certain information; authorizing
11 the ~~director~~ Baltimore City Health Department to include in the Pilot Program, at
12 the discretion of the ~~director~~ Baltimore City Health Department, the implementation
13 of certain policies ~~in the Baltimore City Health Department~~ and the development of
14 a certain referral process or certain integrated partnerships through which certain
15 households may access certain programs or services; requiring the ~~director~~
16 Baltimore City Health Department to attempt to access certain federal funds;
17 requiring the ~~director~~ Baltimore City Health Department to submit a certain report
18 to the Governor and General Assembly on or before a certain date; defining certain
19 terms; requiring, for a certain fiscal year, the Governor to include in the State budget
20 certain funding; providing for the termination of this Act; and generally relating to

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Health – General

SUBTITLE 17A. BREATHE EASY EAST BALTIMORE PILOT PROGRAM.

(A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS
INDICATED.

~~(2) “DIRECTOR” MEANS THE DIRECTOR FOR THE PROGRAM.~~

~~(3)~~ (2) “ELIGIBLE HOUSEHOLD” MEANS A HOUSEHOLD LOCATED
IN EAST BALTIMORE CITY THAT:

(I) HAS A HOUSEHOLD INCOME OF NOT MORE THAN 150% OF
THE FEDERAL POVERTY LEVEL; AND

(II) INCLUDES AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS UNDER THE AGE OF 14 YEARS.

~~(4)~~ (3) "PILOT PROGRAM" MEANS THE BREATHE EASY EAST BALTIMORE PILOT PROGRAM.

(B) (1) ~~IN COOPERATION WITH THE BALTIMORE CITY HEALTH DEPARTMENT AND IN CONSULTATION WITH THE GREEN AND HEALTHY HOMES INITIATIVE, THE DIRECTOR SHALL ESTABLISH THE BREATHE EASY PILOT PROGRAM~~ THERE IS A BREATHE EASY EAST BALTIMORE PILOT PROGRAM IN THE BALTIMORE CITY HEALTH DEPARTMENT.

(2) THE PURPOSE OF THE PILOT PROGRAM IS TO PROVIDE AND STUDY THE EFFECTS OF ASTHMA REMEDIATION SERVICES ON ELIGIBLE HOUSEHOLDS.

(3) ASTHMA REMEDIATION SERVICES PROVIDED BY THE PILOT PROGRAM MAY INCLUDE CLEANING, EDUCATION, STRUCTURAL INTERVENTIONS, AND ANY OTHER SERVICES THE ~~DIRECTOR~~ BALTIMORE CITY HEALTH DEPARTMENT, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE GREEN AND HEALTHY HOMES INITIATIVE, DETERMINES TO BE NECESSARY.

(C) THE ~~DIRECTOR~~ BALTIMORE CITY HEALTH DEPARTMENT, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE GREEN AND HEALTHY HOMES INITIATIVE, SHALL:

(1) ON OR BEFORE JULY 1, 2020, SELECT ELIGIBLE HOUSEHOLDS TO PARTICIPATE IN THE PILOT PROGRAM;

(2) PROVIDE PARTICIPATING ELIGIBLE HOUSEHOLDS WITH ASTHMA REMEDIATION SERVICES; AND

(3) STUDY THE EFFECT THAT ASTHMA REMEDIATION SERVICES HAVE ON THE WELL-BEING OF MEMBERS OF PARTICIPATING ELIGIBLE HOUSEHOLDS BY MEASURING, RELATIVE TO INDIVIDUALS WHO DO NOT RECEIVE ASTHMA REMEDIATION SERVICES:

(I) HEALTH OUTCOMES;

(II) ECONOMIC OUTCOMES; AND

(III) EDUCATIONAL OUTCOMES FOR CHILDREN.

(D) IN ADDITION TO THE ITEMS LISTED IN SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION, THE ~~DIRECTOR~~ BALTIMORE CITY HEALTH DEPARTMENT MAY INCLUDE IN

1 THE PILOT PROGRAM, AT THE DISCRETION OF THE ~~DIRECTOR~~ BALTIMORE CITY
2 HEALTH DEPARTMENT:

3 (1) IMPLEMENTATION OF POLICIES AND PROCEDURES ~~IN THE~~
4 ~~BALTIMORE CITY HEALTH DEPARTMENT~~ TO ENCOURAGE PARTICIPATION IN THE
5 PILOT PROGRAM; AND

6 (2) DEVELOPMENT OF A ~~BALTIMORE CITY HEALTH DEPARTMENT~~
7 REFERRAL PROCESS OR INTEGRATED PARTNERSHIPS WITH OTHER LOCAL OR STATE
8 AGENCIES THROUGH WHICH ELIGIBLE HOUSEHOLDS MAY ACCESS PROGRAMS AND
9 SERVICES THAT TARGET IMPROVED HEALTH.

10 (E) IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER FUNDS AVAILABLE FOR THE PILOT
11 PROGRAM, THE ~~DIRECTOR~~ BALTIMORE CITY HEALTH DEPARTMENT SHALL
12 ATTEMPT TO ACCESS ANY FEDERAL FUNDS RELATED TO ASTHMA REMEDIATION
13 SERVICES FOR HOUSEHOLDS.

14 (F) (1) ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 1, ~~2023~~ 2024, THE ~~DIRECTOR~~
15 BALTIMORE CITY HEALTH DEPARTMENT SHALL REPORT TO THE GOVERNOR AND,
16 IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 2-1246 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, THE
17 GENERAL ASSEMBLY ON THE PILOT PROGRAM.

18 (2) THE REPORT REQUIRED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS
19 SUBSECTION SHALL INCLUDE:

20 (I) THE NUMBER OF ELIGIBLE HOUSEHOLDS PARTICIPATING
21 IN THE PILOT PROGRAM;

22 (II) INFORMATION REGARDING HOW THE PILOT PROGRAM HAS
23 AFFECTED THE HEALTH, ECONOMIC, AND EDUCATIONAL WELL-BEING OF THE
24 MEMBERS OF PARTICIPATING ELIGIBLE HOUSEHOLDS; AND

25 (III) A RECOMMENDATION ON WHETHER THE PILOT PROGRAM
26 SHOULD BE EXTENDED OR EXPANDED.

27 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, for fiscal year 2021, the
28 Governor shall include in the State budget an appropriation of ~~\$500,000~~ \$100,000 to the
29 Baltimore City Health Department for the administration of the Breathe Easy East
30 Baltimore Pilot Program established under ~~§ 13-1707~~ § 13-17A-01 of the Health – General
31 Article, as enacted by Section 1 of this Act.

32 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
33 1, 2019. It shall remain effective for a period of ~~5~~ 6 years and, at the end of June 30, ~~2024~~
34 2025, this Act, with no further action required by the General Assembly, shall be abrogated
35 and of no further force and effect.
