# 2 Motor <u>and Electric</u> Scooter Sharing Companies – Nonvisual Access

- FOR the purpose of requiring that motor scooter sharing companies include on each motor scooter a <u>or electric low speed scooter made available to the public an embossed</u> tactile phone number through which certain individuals may contact the company; requiring that motor <u>or electric</u> scooter sharing companies provide certain individuals with certain nonvisual access that is consistent with certain federal standards; defining certain terms; and generally relating to nonvisual access for motor <u>and electric</u> scooter sharing companies.

1 (A) A MOTOR <u>OR ELECTRIC</u> SCOOTER SHARING COMPANY SHALL INCLUDE 2 ON EACH MOTOR SCOOTER <u>A OR ELECTRIC LOW SPEED SCOOTER MADE AVAILABLE</u> 3 <u>TO THE PUBLIC AN EMBOSSED</u> TACTILE PHONE NUMBER THROUGH WHICH AN 4 INDIVIDUAL WHO IS BLIND OR HAS A VISUAL IMPAIRMENT MAY CONTACT THE 5 COMPANY.

6 (B) A MOTOR <u>OR ELECTRIC</u> SCOOTER SHARING COMPANY SHALL PROVIDE 7 INDIVIDUALS WITH DISABILITIES NONVISUAL ACCESS TO ITS WEBSITE AND MOBILE 8 APPLICATION IN A WAY THAT:

9 (1) PROVIDES FULL AND EQUAL ACCESSIBILITY TO THE INDIVIDUAL 10 WITH DISABILITIES SO THAT THE INDIVIDUAL IS ABLE TO ACQUIRE THE SAME 11 INFORMATION, ENGAGE IN THE SAME INTERACTIONS, AND ENJOY THE SAME 12 SERVICES AS USERS WITHOUT DISABILITIES, WITH SUBSTANTIALLY EQUIVALENT 13 EASE OF USE; AND

14(2)IS CONSISTENT WITH THE STANDARDS OF § 508 OF THE FEDERAL15REHABILITATION ACT OF 1973.

16 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 17 October 1, 2019.
