A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Department of Human Services – Child Support Services – Study and Report

FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of Human Services, in consultation with the
Department of Labor, Licensing, and Regulation and certain organizations, to review
certain child support laws and policies, study certain child support best practices,
and recommend certain statutory and policy changes; requiring the Department of
Human Services to report its findings and recommendations to certain committees
of the General Assembly on or before a certain date; and generally relating to child
support services.

10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 11 That:

12 (a) The Department of Human Services, in consultation with the Department of 13 Labor, Licensing, and Regulation, the Center for Urban Families, Equity Matters, and 14 other local providers and policy organizations, shall:

15 (1) review State child support laws and policies related to noncustodial16 parents;

17 (2) study child support best practices in other states for noncustodial 18 parents; and

- 19 (3) recommend statutory and policy changes to:
- 20 (i) encourage family engagement;
- 21 (ii) assist low-income parents in meeting child support obligations; 22 and
- 23

(iii) promote economic self-sufficiency for noncustodial parents.

1 (b) On or before December 1, 2019, the Department of Human Services shall 2 report to the Senate Finance Committee and the House Appropriations Committee, in 3 accordance with § 2–1246 of the State Government Article, its findings and 4 recommendations on State child support services.

5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 6 1, 2019.
